SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Only one entry per student; grades K–12
- All entries must be postmarked by Monday, September 12, 2016

- Employees of ADL, Barrick Gold, CCSD, RTC, and Vector Media Poster Committee, their board of directors and their immediate family members are not eligible for this competition.
- **Entrants must submit along with artwork a one-paragraph explanation of what his/her artwork represents. The entrant's name, school, or city should NOT appear anywhere in the paragraph.**
- Entrants must complete an entry form and securely clip it to the front of their artwork. The entry form must include the following information:
 - Student's name, home address, and phone number
 - Teacher's name
 - The name and address of entrant's current school
- Teachers may submit entries for students, however, to qualify, each piece of artwork must include a completed entry form attached to the FRONT of the artwork.
- Entries will not be returned.

ARTWORK GUIDELINES

- Entrants must submit an original, unpublished work of art — illustration or photograph. Submissions should not exceed 24" x 36". Sculpture and multi-dimensional art pieces are not permitted.
- Illustrations may be in one or more of the following media: painting (choice of watercolor, acrylic, ink, oil, and other), drawing, collage, and print (including silk-screens, lithographs, etc.)
- Photographs may be color or black and white.
- It is recommended that illustrations and photographs be mounted on poster board.
- The entrant's name, school, or city should not appear anywhere on the artwork.

JUDGING GUIDELINES

- Each entry will be evaluated and numbered as it advances. Entry forms are removed during the judging process to ensure that judging is based solely on the merit of the artwork.
- Students will be entered into one of three current grade categories: K-5, 6-8, or 9-12
- Artwork will be judged on originality, creativity, design, and interpretation of the theme appropriate to entrant's grade level.
- Once the judging has been completed, entry forms will be reattached to the winning artwork and winners and their teachers, if applicable, will be notified.
- Application of the judging guidelines will be at the judges' sole and absolute discretion. The judges' decisions are final in all matters relating to this contest.
