Awards recognize district for highest level of financial reporting

LAS VEGAS – Clark County School District (CCSD) has been recognized with the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting by the <u>Government Finance Officers</u>
<u>Association of the United States and Canada</u> (GFOA) for its comprehensive annual financial report (CAFR). The certificate of achievement is the highest form of recognition in the area of governmental accounting and financial reporting. CCSD has received this award for the past 34 years.

Additionally, CCSD has earned the GFOA Award for Outstanding Achievement in Popular Annual Financial Reporting. The award is based on an evaluation of the District's CAFR for reader appeal, understandability, distribution methods, creativity and other elements.
