## LAS VEGAS - 5.02 2021-2022 School Calendars for Staff and Students

The Board of School Trustees held a discussion regarding an amendment to the 2021-22 school calendar for staff and students. The board voted unanimously to approve the suggested changes.

These calendar changes align with existing procedures and policies regarding pay for contingency days. Based on these changes, the following adjustments were made to the 2021-2022 school calendar:

- Monday, February 7, 2022
  - Full day of instruction
  - Previously a contingency day
- Monday, April 25, 2022
  - Full day of instruction
  - Previously a staff development day


The new agreement modifies the current MOA by adding the nationally recognized Juneteenth holiday for 12-month administrators.
