

**RESOLUTION**  
**Commitment to Students**  
**Regardless of Immigration Status**

WHEREAS, the Clark County School District, (the "District") affirms its core values including equity and inclusion in a welcoming, safe, and respectful community;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the District and members of our academic community and peers are concerned about the recent increase in hate crimes and inflammatory language concerning immigration around the United States, including our schools;

WHEREAS, there have been examples of threats against immigrants during and after the divisive 2016 presidential election;

WHEREAS, the proposed immigration policies of the incoming presidential administration could cause a disruption to the safety and security of members of our educational community and their families, particularly those students and staff without the privilege of U.S. citizenship;

WHEREAS, current federal policy states that U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement ("ICE") officers are subject to certain restrictions upon entering our campuses, and should avoid prosecuting K-12 students. Enforcement actions covered by the policy include arrests, interviews, searches, and surveillance for the purpose of immigration enforcement; and

WHEREAS, many educational institutions throughout the country are enacting resolutions and policies to show their continued commitment to making schools a safe space for students to learn regardless of their immigration status.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees hereby declares the following:

1. District property is a safe space for students, staff, and the educational community regardless of their immigration status.
2. Student privacy will be protected by restricting the release of confidential student information about students' immigration status to immigration enforcement agencies, including ICE, unless there is parent consent, a judicial warrant, subpoena, or court order.
3. School police will be instructed to assist ICE as legally required for the purposes of immigration enforcement.


4. Access to campus will be granted to federal immigration officials for the purpose of immigration enforcement as legally required to do so (e.g., when there is a warrant) or in the event of exigent circumstances.

5. The District will implement a forum for ongoing feedback from District students and staff about these immigration issues and potential additional future actions to help protect the safety and dignity of the educational community regardless of a person's immigration status.
