



How do I schedule the booster/second dose appointment?

- If you received your initial vaccination from UNLV/CSN Henderson, you were automatically scheduled for a follow-up date and time. The second appointment is listed on the back of your vaccination card. You will also receive an email reminder of your booster appointment three days and one day prior to your appointment.
- If you received your initial dose at a Southern Nevada Health District (SNHD) site (i.e. Western High School, Cashman Center or Jerome Mack Middle School) it is highly recommended you schedule an appointment with SNHD for your second dose.
 - However, if you received a Moderna vaccination at a SNHD site at least 28 days prior and have not been able to make an appointment, the Las Vegas Convention Center is accepting walk-ins. Walk-in appointments are for those needing their second doses only and served based on vaccine availability.
 - The Las Vegas Convention Center clinic is open Tuesday through Saturday. If you have additional questions, please contact our call center, Monday through Friday, from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at (702) 759-1900.
 - This table provides a brief overview of when you would be able to pursue the walk-in appointment.
